Thanks to the generosity of Manitobans, the Foundation provided \$5.36 million in grants to CancerCare Manitoba this year. Our funding supports patient care, research operations and equipment purchases as well as education and public awareness about ways to reduce your risk of cancer.

Most important, this funding helps Manitobans and their families living with cancer - Manitobans like Marlene Kachur who is living proof that More Tomorrows are possible.

World-Class Facility Brings Relief and Hope

When Marlene Kachur was diagnosed with chronic Lymphocytic leukemia (CLL), she was told that if she was very lucky, she had eight years left to live. Her immediate thought was, "that's not enough". That was 19 years ago.

"I'm relieved that something like this is here to help," Marlene says. "I'm very proud that I'm still going, and I have faith that it's going to turn out all right."

Thanks to generosity of the Foundation's donors, Marlene has access to leading CLL specialists at a world-class facility - right here in Manitoba. It's the only one in Canada dedicated to the study and treatment of her disease.

Marlene's physician is Dr. James Johnston, who moved here from Ireland more than 30 years ago. He describes CancerCare Manitoba's facility as ideal because the lab and clinic are in close proximity, which fosters strong ties between research and treatment. It's also home to the country's largest CLL tumour bank - the hub of research programs.

Dr. Johnston explains, "Tumour samples from the bank are used for research in the lab. We're examining new therapies and better treatments that can be applied in the clinic as trials." He adds, "It's highly advantageous to have a dedicated group of diverse specialists working closely together."

For CLL patients, this integrated model means they get comprehensive care without leaving the clinic - something few centres can offer.

In addition to clinical trials, patients at CancerCare Manitoba can participate in the Familial CLL Study. Dr. Johnston and his fellow scientists are the only Canadian group involved in this quest to find the gene that causes CLL to occur in families. As a mother of four, Marlene is hopeful that doctors will soon be able to accurately predict risk for family members.



On the Edge of a Breakthrough

The CLL team is on the edge of an exciting breakthrough in another research program to determine why some people live with CLL for decades with little or no symptoms, while in others it progresses swiftly. They have discovered an abnormality that is an early sign of the cancer. This abnormal cell could allow doctors to accurately predict which patients have an aggressive form of the disease before their lives are in jeopardy.

"Most CLL patients will die of this disease or its consequences," Dr. Johnston says. "Research is the only way to improve patient care and outcomes."

Special Events

CancerCare Manitoba Foundation holds four signature events each year and another 400+ community events register to raise funds for the Foundation. In 2012/2013 these events accounted for approximately 35% of the Foundation's total net revenue.



The Challenge for Life 20km Walk raises funds for All Cancers and provides an opportunity for participants to reduce their own risk of cancer by improving their personal fitness. The 2012 CFL raised \$1 million thanks to corporate sponsors and more than 15,000 individual donors who supported more than 600 individuals who walked 20km and 'rang the bells' as they crossed the finish line in Assiniboine Park.




