Winnipeg, Manitoba June 8, 2019 – CancerCare Manitoba Foundation's 12th annual Challenge for Life was held today, raising \$1,084,576 in support of CancerCare Manitoba. Nearly 800 participants either walked 20 kilometres or worked out for 200 minutes of fitness.

The inaugural Challenge for Life Walk was held in 2008. Between 2008 and 2019, over \$12 million has been raised by supporters and donors of this event. All funds raised stay in Manitoba and support prevention, early detection, treatment, research and patient support at CancerCare Manitoba.

"The funds raised at Challenge for Life are integral to making progress against this terrible disease which affects so many of our family members and friends," said Annitta Stenning, President and CEO, CancerCare Manitoba Foundation. "We are very grateful for the dedication and energy of all the participants, sponsors, donors and volunteers who rose to the Challenge once again this year."

The nearly \$1.1 million raised at today's Challenge for Life is a key source of the almost \$7 million the Foundation is granting to CancerCare Manitoba this year. Since 2000, thanks to the generosity of supporters and donors, the Foundation has been able to provide over \$125 million to CancerCare Manitoba. These funds change and save lives.

They play a pivotal role in advancing treatments and allowing health-care professionals to better understand medications' lasting effectiveness and side effects.
