The new initiative: #CCMFSnowAngels was inspired by a fundraiser created in 2020 by Carol Ploen-Hosegood who started Alley's Angels Snow Angel Challenge in memory of her friend Alley who passed away from cancer.

"As I made my snow angel in memory of Alley I looked up into the sky and it was a special moment to pause and think of my dear friend," said Carol. "Making our snow angels was a way to come together in spirit when we couldn't in person. It was our way to honour our friend who we cared so deeply for. We wanted to help do what we could to raise funds because we know the devastating impact of losing someone you love."
